I want the 1st Pembury Scout Group to treat all subscriptions and other donations I have made in the past 4 years and all future donations as Gift Aid donations.

I confirm I have paid or will pay an amount of Income Tax and/or Capital Gains Tax for each tax year (6 April to 5 April) that is at least equal to the amount of tax that all the charities or Community Amateur Sports Clubs (CASCs) that I donate to will reclaim on my gifts for that tax year. I understand that other taxes such as VAT and Council Tax do not qualify. I understand the charity will reclaim 28p of tax on every £1 that I gave up to 5 April 2008 and will reclaim 25p of tax on every £1 that I give on or after 6 April 2008.

Tax claimed by The 1st Pembury Scout Group

- The Scout Association will reclaim 25p of tax on every £1 you give on or after 6 April 2008.
- The Government will pay to The Scout Association an additional 3p on every £1 you gave between 6 April 2008 and 5 April 2011. This transitional relief for The Scout Association does not affect your personal tax position.

If you pay Income Tax at the higher or additional rate and want to receive the additional tax relief due to you, you must include all your Gift Aid donations on your Self Assessment tax return or ask HM Revenue and Customs to adjust your tax code.
